According to verse 3, what sins have no place among God's people? 4. Looking at verse 4, what is not for you? What should you do instead? Is there a time where saying "coarse jokes" or "foolish talk" is okay? (Verse 6 and 7) 5. Verse 8 says to live as "people of light." What does the light produce? (Verse 9)
