



No Other Gospel

Read Galatians 1:6-12 NIV

1. The author of Galatians is the Apostle Paul. Look at verse 6, what is astonishing to Paul? What are the people turning to instead? At which speed are they doing this? How do you see this happening today?

2. Look at verse 7, Paul talks about people doing things on purpose. What are they doing on purpose? What does it mean when he says, "pervert the Gospel"? Is a perverted gospel valid at all? Look at the end of verse one and beginning of verse two.

3. According to verse 8, why would Paul warn us about angels here? Do angels have the ability to lie? Why or why not? Who is the most popular lying angel? Do you think any of the religions we have today have started because angels lied to man? What happens when we preach a different gospel?

4. Look at verse 8 and 9. Did you notice they are almost the same? If Paul was saying this out loud to the Galatians, what do you think his tone of voice would have been? Why do you think he wrote it down twice? Was Paul trying to bring clarity to the Galatians or was he trying to prevent them from falling into a perverted gospel? Or both?





5. According to verse 10, whose approval should we try to win? Do you see people seeking the approval of men rather than God's approval in your daily life? Is it possible to please both at the same time? Look at the end of verse 10. Describe a time when you felt the struggle between pleasing a friend or pleasing God? How did you resolve it?

6. The title of this devotional is "No Other Gospel." Why are false gospels so dangerous? Are they man pleasing or God pleasing? What do you mean?

7. Who alone revealed the true Gospel to Paul? Is this better than receiving it from an angel?

8. Write a prayer asking God to give you clarity on what His truth is. Ask Him to help you identify where you have opened the door to false gospels so that you can address them in your life.
